

QUILT PIECING FUNDAMENTALS SUPPLY LIST

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Sewing machine: Be sure your machine is in good working order and that you have used it in the last three months so you are familiar with the basic functions of your machine. This is not a class on how to use your sewing machine; you should be very friendly with your machine before class.

Straight pins (long, fine pins are best)

Scissors, Rotary Cutter, Seam Ripper

Cutting mat (you don't need to bring this to class, but will use it at home)

Quilting ruler

100% cotton thread in a neutral color – 50 weight thread is good

¼” quilting foot (if possible) – if you don't have one, we will determine how to achieve a good quarter inch seam without it

Pencil and notepaper

Bring your own lunch

Fabric requirements for finished size approximately 43” x 54”

2 yards of focus fabric (sample has a rabbit design)

½ yard each of three colors (sample used pink, blue, and stripe)

¼ yard (not a fat quarter) for the inner border (sample used blue)

½ yard for the binding (sample used stripe)
