

THE HIDEOUT BAG SUPPLY LIST

The Hideout Bag pattern available from fireweedstitches.com as a PDF download for \$10. Please do not share patterns

Main fabric—under $\frac{1}{4}$ yd I recommend cork or vinyl. If you use cotton make sure you interface your pieces

Accent fabric—small scrap

Lining fabric— $\frac{1}{2}$ yd

Fusible woven interfacing such as Pellon— $\frac{1}{2}$ yd

Canvas or other heavy fabric such as duck or denim— $\frac{1}{4}$ yd

6inch x 8 inch piece of batting

46 inches of #5 zipper tape, with 5 zipper pulls. You can buy this by the yard at Cloth Plus or get it online.

65 inches of strap material. The width needs to be the same as your D rings.

2 D rings. These can be $\frac{3}{4}$ inch to 1 inch and should be the same width as your strap material.

2 lobster clasps the same width as your straps.

1 tri-glid slide the same width as your straps.

Double sided tape—optional

Thread to match your project

Zipper foot

1/4inch foot

Wonder clips

Marking pens

Water soluble glue stick

Sewing machine in good working order with the power cord , foot pedal and tray table

Size 14 or 16 jeans needles—bring extras

Rotary mat and cutter

Pins, seam ripper, scissors, snips, whatever else you need for a day of sewing

BEFORE COMING TO CLASS PLEASE CUT OUT AND LABEL ALL PIECES ACCORDING TO THE CHART ON PAGE 2 OF YOUR PATTERN

You may order the hardware and accessories from Fireweed Stitches, Another source is Sallie Tomato. You can also find them locally at craft and fabric stores.
