The bag we will be making is a pattern called the Easy Does It by ByAnnie. When you sign-up for the class, you will receive the pattern. (Do not lose this pattern as it is the only copy you will receive.) On workshop day, the guild will provide irons and ironing boards, cutting mats, rotary cutters, plugs, rulers and a work table.

To make your life easier,

PLEASE USE NON-DIRECTIONAL FABRIC

ARE YOU AFRAID OF ZIPPERS? Now is your chance to install a zipper, with help.

Let's overcome your zipper phobia while making this beautiful bag!

Regarding zippers:

A #5 zipper works best. Cloth Plus sells zippers-by-the-yard in limited basic colors and Whitney will install the zipper pull. Coco's Prescott Quilt Works has zippers & so does Sew 'n Sew n Chino Valley

SUPPLIES/NOTIONS NEEDED

Follow the directions given on the pattern for supplies

PRIOR TO CLASS:

TO AVOID CONFUSION LATER, BE SURE TO LABEL ALL YOUR CUT PIECES

1. Follow pattern directions I. A-C. When you arrive to class your fabric should be quilted, pieces cut out and labeled and ready to sew. If you have any questions about this process, call me.

NOTE: On Step B, use a **walking foot** to quilt your three sandwiched pieces together.

On Step C, 'Seal Edges' means to zigzag all around the edges on each sandwiched piece. This compresses the edges and makes them easier to sew together in later steps.
