In this class we will discuss different methods of approaching fabric collage. You will learn options you have for fusing or glueing down and assembling your project. We will discuss fabric choices and how to use them to make your creation more interesting. Join in the fun and come create with us.

Pattern:

- Download your pattern of choice from Collage Quilter.

There is a free mushroom pattern available on the Collage Quilter website. The samples for the class are from the Garden Party Pattern.

Please print out your pattern in black and white and bring it to class. Keep in mind, some patterns print on multiple pages and may need to be taped together.

If you already have a pattern, other than one from the Collage Quilter, and you wish to work on in class, please let the instructor know before class.

- Light Steam a Seam 2 – You can start with two yards or one package of 9" x 12" sheets.
- Fabric – A variety of fabrics in your colors of choice, from light to dark. Fabric with a print will give your collage more interest. You may also include fabric you wish to fussy cut and include in your design. (see samples)
4.5' – 6' square pieces will be sufficient to start with
- Prepare enough fabric with fusible to get you started according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Small iron and ironing surface. A small wand iron works well also.
- Fabric scissors – small scissors for fussy cutting are useful.
- Tweezers
- Parchment Paper
- 1/4" piece of foam core covered in felt. (not required)
- A Light box is helpful if you have one.
- Pencil and felt tip marker.
- Straight Pins.
