# **Category Definitions**

Pieced	A quilt that has been made using traditional piecing techniques.
Appliquéd	A quilt that is predominantly appliquéd, either by hand or machine.
Mixed Techniques	A quilt that does not obviously fit into any other category.  A Quilt that uses equal amounts of two major techniques, such as piecing and appliqué may fall within this category.  Quilts made using techniques other than piecing and appliqué, such as whole cloth, yo-yo, or crazy quilts belong in this category, as well as quilts incorporating, embroidery, photo transfers, embellishments, etc.
Art	A quilt that shows personal creativity and originality.  Art quilts are designed to inspire, not keep you warm. They may be abstract or realistic and may use materials that are unusual in traditional quilts.
Other	Quilted accessories, such as items table toppers, purses, totes.  Wearable items such as jackets and vests should be entered in the Other category.

#### **QUILT ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Only <u>current</u> members of Mountain Top Quilters Guild (MTQG) may enter quilts in the *2024* quilt show. If you are not a member, please consider joining.
- 2. Each member may enter up to <u>five</u> quilts, including group quilts. A separate Entry Form must be completed for each quilt.
- 3. The member will indicate the priority of each quilt in case more quilts are entered than can be displayed. Quilts will be eliminated based on the priority given by the owner.
- 4. Quilts must be made by the member entering the quilt or by another MTQG member(s).
- 5. Quilts may <u>not</u> have been shown in a local quad-city area quilt show within the previous five years (2019 2024). Entry into the Yavapai County Fair is permitted.
- 6. The public will be invited to vote for their favorite quilt in each category. The member is responsible for identifying the appropriate category for their quilt.
- 7. All quilts must have a Hanging Sleeve properly sewn on the quilt's back. There will be NO exceptions. Please follow the instructions found on the MTQG website.
- 8. A personal label that includes your name and the quilt's name must be affixed to the back in the lower left corner (as you are looking at the back).
- 9. In order to be displayed a quilt must be in good repair, clean and free of stains, animal hair, and odors, including smoke.
- 10. The completed Entry Forms may be handed in at the General Meetings from **January 15, 2024 through April 15, 2024** or mailed no later than **April 15** to MTQG P.O. Box 12961, Prescott, AZ 86304-2961.
- 11. Quilt drop-off instructions, hanging ID label, and entry bag will be provided for each quilt entry at the May 20, 2024 meeting. Please plan to attend or arrange for a friend to pick up your envelope.
- 12. Unless instructed differently in the drop-off instructions, plan to deliver your quilt(s) to Findlay Toyota Center, 3201 N. Main St., Prescott Valley, AZ between 8:15 and 9:30 a.m. on Thursday, May 30, 2024 Quilts can be picked-up from 5:00-6:00 on Saturday, June 1, 2024. If a member is not able to drop-off and/or pick-up their quilt(s) a friend may do so, with the proper paperwork.
