Fabric Requirements:

Light (background) 1-1/2 yards

Dark (star part, inside petal

and outside arrows) ¹/₂ yard

Medium (star part) (1/4 yard)

Bright (center) 1/8 yard

Multi Medium (sashing)

Long pieces that connect 1/3 yard

Backing Fabric: 1 yard

Batting: At least 36x36



This is great pattern and the color combinations make it exciting. Contrast is an important element. Audition your fabrics!

Organization of your supplies will assist you in this project.

Also bring:

Binding Fabric:

- Sewing machine and basic sewing supplies; <u>new needle</u> in machine; <u>new cutting</u> <u>blade</u> in rotary cutter. Scissors, seam ripper, pins, etc.
- Top Stitching threads to match background.
- Ruler: 6 x 24 and/or 3 x18; 6 inch ruler sometimes helpful.
- **Pattern: Mexican Star**/by A. Ornelas: Note: Also <u>make a COPY of your own</u> pattern to create notes and note color changes and a pencil.
- Small iron and ironing surface very handy
- Small Post-A-Note type papers: we will be labeling our pieces
- Quart size plastic bags
- Handi-Wipe or two

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- Glue Stick/Dries clear (small)
- Fabric Clips and pins
- Pencil and highlighter

PRIOR TO CLASS:

- ON THE COPY OF YOUR PATTERN:
 - o Page 1: Label the colors of YOUR FABRICS in the 5 boxes listed. Snip a sample and attach.

IT IS SUGGESTED THAT YOU:

- <u>Cut the fabrics as listed on page 1 only.</u> Take special notice to the sizes and cut exact. Notice the strips and then the sub-cuts.
 - If you do cut, be sure to LABEL AND PUT IN INDIVIDUAL BAGS !
 - If you want assistance, you may also wait until class.
