# MTQG BAG WORKSHOP

The bag we will be making is a FREE pattern called the Baker Street Bag by Sew Sweetness. Each attendee will need to PRINT the pattern and bring it to class. **NOTE:** Be sure to print the pattern piece at 'ACTUAL' size. (You should print out two of the pattern piece and tape them together. This way you are working with a FULL size pattern.) On workshop day, the guild will provide irons and ironing boards, cutting mats, rotary cutters, rulers and a work table.

## PLEASE USE NON-DIRECTIONAL FABRIC

ARE YOU AFRAID OF ZIPPERS? Now is your chance to install a zipper, with help. Let's overcome your zipper phobia while making this beautiful bag!

### **SUPPLIES/NOTIONS NEEDED**

- -1 yd exterior fabric
- -1 yd lining fabric
- -1 yd By Annie Soft & Stable\* or Pellon Flex Foam (either fusible on one side ONLY)
- -1 vd Pellon SF 101
- -16 inch #5 zipper (can be longer)\*\*
- -60 inches of webbing, 1 inch wide (will make two 30" straps. Add extra length if you want longer straps. These will be covered so any color of webbing will suffice, but I suggest a light color\*\*\*

- -90/14 needle or Denim needle + extras
- -Thread matching exterior and lining fabrics
- -Sewing Machine + cord and foot pedal
- -Basic sewing supplies
- -Zipper Foot
- -Walking Foot
- -2 Large safety pins or a Bodkin (but I like safety pins, so bring them either way, you'll see why!)

### **PRIOR TO CLASS:**

<sup>\*</sup>Soft and Stable is sold in packages of 1 yd x 58 inches.

<sup>\*\*</sup>A #5 zipper works best. Cloth Plus sells zippers-by-the-yard in limited basic colors and Whitney will install the zipper pull. Hobby Lobby sometimes has a few #5 zippers.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup> Webbing can also be bought at Cloth Plus. Choose a light color so it will not show thru your exterior fabric.

#### TO AVOID CONFUSION LATER, BE SURE TO LABEL ALL YOUR CUT PIECES

1. Exterior fabric – cut 20H x 14W piece (exterior - front and back)

Soft & Stable – cut 20H x 14W piece

Fuse these two together following Manufacturer's instructions. You can leave 'as is' or quilt as desired on your embroidery machine, OR, quilt vertical lines 1 inch apart or cross hatch lines 1 inch apart on your domestic machine using your walking foot!

- 2. From Exterior fabric (after you cut the 20H x14W piece in #1), cut:
  - $1 30H \times 5W$  (side panel)
- 3. From Soft & Stable cut:
  - $1 30H \times 5W$  (side panel)

Sandwich the Side Panel exterior to the Soft & Stable Side Panel and fuse according to the Manufacturer's directions. Using a Walking Foot, quilt as desired, OR, sew long vertical lines, about 1 inch apart, down the entire piece, OR, leave 'as is' without any quilting, if you left 'as is' in #1)

4. Lining fabric – cut 32H x 14W (lining – front, back, and inside pockets)

SF 101 - cut 32H x 14W piece

Fuse these two together following Manufacturer's instructions. Set aside.

- 5. From Lining fabric (after you cut the 32H x 14W piece in #4), cut:
  - 1 30H x 5W (side panel)
  - 1 11H x 8 ¾ W (inside bottom of bag I will provide hard bottom piece)
  - $2 10H \times 2 \frac{1}{2} W$  zipper panels
  - 2 3H x 2 ½ W zipper tabs

(NO INTERFACING REQURED FOR ZIPPER PANELS OR ZIPPER TABS)

I like the zipper panels and zipper tabs to match the lining. If you prefer, you can cut them out of your exterior fabric.

- 6. From SF 101 cut:
  - $1 30H \times 5W$  (side panel)

Sandwich the Side Panel lining to the SF101 Side Panel and fuse according to the Manufacturer's directions. Set aside.

OPTIONAL FRONT POCKET: If desired, you can add a front outside pocket (see samples). Plan to do this in class, but bring any trims you want to include (rick rack, ribbon, lace, piping, etc).
