**QUILT ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Only current members of Mountain Top Quilters Guild (MTQG) may enter quilts in the *2020 Visions of Quilts* quilt show. If you are not a member, please consider joining.
2. Each member may enter up to **five** quilts. A separate Entry Form must be completed for each quilt.
3. The member will indicate the priority of each quilt, so that if more quilts are entered than can be displayed, quilts will be eliminated based on the priority given by the owner.
4. Quilts must be made by the member entering the quilt or by another MTQG member(s).
5. Quilts may not have been shown in a local quad-city area quilt show within the previous five years (2015 – 2020). Entry into the Yavapai County Fair is permitted.
6. The public will be invited to vote for their favorite quilt in each category. The member is responsible for identifying the appropriate category for their quilt.
7. All quilts must have a Hanging Sleeve properly sewn on the quilt's back. Please use the instructions found on the MTQG website under the Quilt Shows tab.
8. A personal label that includes your name and the quilt's name must be affixed to the back in the lower left corner (as you are looking at the quilt back).
9. In order to be displayed a quilt must be in good repair, clean and free of stains, animal hair, and odors, including smoke.
10. The deadline for completed Entry Forms to be received is **April 20, 2020**. Return form to the Welcome Table at the monthly MTQG meeting or mail to MTQG c/o M. Jacobson 363 Rim Trl, Prescott, AZ 86303.
11. Quilt drop-off instructions, hanging ID label, and entry bag will be provided for each quilt entry at the May 18, 2020 meeting. Please plan to attend or arrange for a friend to pick up your quilt entry envelope.
12. Unless instructed differently in the drop-off instructions, plan to deliver your quilts to Findlay Toyota Center, 3201 N. Main St., Prescott Valley, AZ between 8:15 and 9:30 a.m. on Thursday, June 4, 2020. Quilts can be picked-up from 4:30 – 5:30 on Saturday, June 6, 2020. If a member is not able to drop-off and/or pick-up their quilt(s) a friend may do so, with the proper paperwork.

## Category Definitions

Pieced	A quilt that is made using traditional piecing techniques.
Appliquéd	A quilt that is predominantly appliquéd, either by hand or machine.
Mixed Technique	Any quilt that does not obviously fit into another category. A quilt that uses equal amounts of two major techniques, such as piecing and appliqué, may fall within this category. Quilts made using techniques other than piecing and applique, such as whole cloth, yo-yo, or crazy quilts belong in this category, as well as quilts incorporating embroidery, photo transfers, embellishments, etc.
Art	A quilt that shows personal creativity and originality. Art quilts are designed to inspire, not to keep you warm. They can be abstract or realistic and may use materials that are unusual in traditional quilts.
Other	Quilted accessories, such as table toppers, purses and totes and wearable items like jackets and vest should be entered in the Other category.
