Tangled Daisies Workshop

This workshop will focus on applique. You will learn Jill's method, which gives beautiful results, even for the beginner. In this class, you will learn a prepared-edge method, rounded edges, sharp points, circles, making and shaping bias tape vines, shadowing. In addition Jill will teach her applique stitching method so that no stitches show and you develop the beautiful puff or lift on each piece.

This table runner has very little piecing, but the background can be pieced before class. We won't need machines at this class.

 - 1/8 yard yellow (applique)
 - 1/8 yard EACH two green prints (applique)
- *½" Bias Tape Maker

- *Jillily Studio applique tools: Starch Brush, Quilter's Digit, Appli-Glue.
 Poke-A-Dots, Bohin Needles-size 11 applique
- Spray starch
