

Block of the Month 2015 - 2016 April



Miners Lamp 10 inch block

Color #1 light cut two $4 \frac{7}{8}$ inch squares and five $2 \frac{1}{2}$ inch squares

Color #2 dark cut two $4 \frac{7}{8}$ squares and four $2 \frac{1}{2}$ inch squares

Stack one color #1 and one color #2 $4 \frac{7}{8}$ inch squares. Draw a diagonal line and sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ inch on each side make 2. Cut on diagonal center line. Press seam to darker side. Square up to $4 \frac{1}{2}$.

Sew one color #1 $2 \frac{1}{2}$ inch square and one color #2 $2 \frac{1}{2}$ inch square together to form a $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangle.

Lay out as shown above into three horizontal rows and sew rows together. Square to $10 \frac{1}{2}$ inches
