

MOUNTAIN TOP QUILTERS GUILD – 2020 VISIONS OF QUILTS QUILT SHOW

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

I don't think my quilts are "good enough" to be shown in a quilt show. Do you really want me to enter some? Yes! We want to showcase the work of all of our members whether you are a master quilter or just finished your first quilt, no matter how many quilts you've made or if you think your quilt is good enough. The show is not judged and our viewers appreciate seeing a variety of styles and skill levels.

How many quilts can I enter in the show? Five. Please complete a Quilt Show Entry Form for each quilt. If the quilt requires an Entry Form it counts toward the five quilts you can enter.

I made a quilt as part of the Community Quilt Challenge. Do I need to complete a Quilt Show Entry Form for it? No. These quilts will be entered as a group by the Challenge Chairperson and do not count as one of the five quilts you can enter.

I made a quilt as part of the Celebrating 100 Years of the Women's Right to Vote challenge. Do I need to complete a Quilt Show Entry Form for it? Yes. Please indicate that it is to be hung with other Women's Right to Vote Challenge quilts.

I want to display the quilt that I made as part of a challenge in my mini group. Do I need to complete a Quilt Show Entry Form for it? Yes. Please indicate the name of the challenge and the mini group on the Entry Form.

I am donating a quilt to the Small Quilt Auction. Do I need to complete a Quilt Show Entry Form for it? No, there is a separate form and process for the Small Quilt Auction. Please find the correct form on the website under the Quilt Shows tab.

I have a quilt I want included in the Quilts with a Story presentation. Do I need to complete a Quilt Show Entry Form for it? No, there is a separate form and process for Quilts with a Story. Please find the correct form on the website under the Quilt Shows tab.

Why do we have to choose a Category for our quilt? The public will be invited to

vote on their favorite quilt by category. You are responsible for choosing the ONE category in which your quilt will be viewed. We realize that at times a quilt may fit into more than one category. Please refer to the Category Definitions that are included with the Instructions and choose the one that you think is the best fit.

Why am I asked to assign a Priority to each quilt I enter? While Findlay Toyota Center is very large, there is a limit to the number of quilts that can be displayed. Though it has never happened, if we are fortunate enough to have too many quilts to display, the Quilt Show Committee will begin to eliminate quilts, starting with those the maker has prioritized as 5.

I've already printed out the 3-page Quilt Show Entry Form and instructions. How can I get a copy of just the Entry Form without the instructions? There are two ways to do this. After printing out the full 3-page form and instructions, just make additional copies of the Entry Form on a copy machine. The other option is to go into the Print Menu after opening the document and choose to only print page 3.

What is the deadline for turning in the Quilt Show Entry Form? All Entry Forms must be submitted by July 20.

When must my quilt be finished and turned in? The good news is that you have until September 3 to finish your quilt as you will be turning your quilt in at the Findlay Toyota Center between 8:15 - 9:30 AM.
